the perspective of different technologies used for marketing to broaden the business ideas on social platforms.

Event details:

The entire course was of 5 days, starting from 22nd November 2021 to 26th November 2021. Mr. Abhilash Sonvane, (Angel Investor) was the speaker for the 1st day and he gave the talk on Technology start up fundamentals. Some of the major concepts covered by him were design thinking and ideation for tech start-ups. The next session of day 1 was taken by Priyanka Bajaj (Associate IPR, GUSEC) on IPR in tech start-ups. Legal aspects are one of the most important parts of any business start-up or entrepreneur. Knowledge from recent IP allied technologies will help the people to manage IP related documentations. 2nd day of the course was taken by Ruchit Patel (Co-Founder of AllEvents.in). The session covered topics related to new-age technologies used by start-ups. On 3rd day the speaker was Anupama Panchal (Co-Founder of Client Joy). In her talk, she briefed us about the technologies that are required to start entrepreneurship with the help of outsourcing technology and the process to develop a tech team. On the 4th day, the speaker for the 1st session was Mr. Sahil Shah (Founder of Net savvies Media Co.) and he briefed us regarding productivity tools for building a strong foundation for start-up. The next session of the 4th day was taken by Akansha Bhadoria (Senior Associate-Growth GUSEC) and she presented her talk on Cloud Support Systems. Finally, 5th day of the program was taken by Sunny Vaghela (Founder & CEO, Tech defence lab) and he addressed the topic of start-ups and cyber security. The entire event has helped the staff of E-YUVA Centre develop knowledge.


